## PAIRING GUIDE



Pairing your phone<sup>2</sup> is the first step in connecting with your Toyota for hands-free calling and for audio streaming via *Bluetooth*<sup>®</sup>.

The pairing process is quick and easy: all iPhone<sup>®3</sup> mobile digital devices and Android<sup>™4</sup> smartphones have *Bluetooth*<sup>®</sup> integrated; all you have to do is setup the phone and multimedia system to “talk” to each other and form a connection<sup>2</sup>.

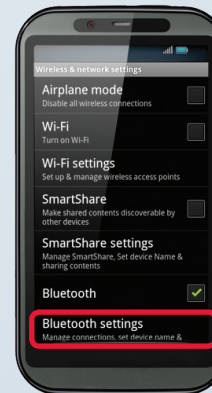
Select **Settings**.

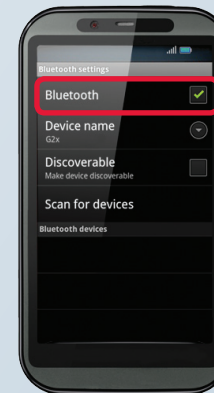
Select **Wireless & networks**.

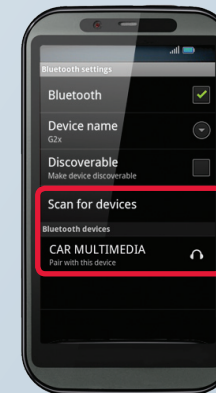
Select **Bluetooth settings**.

Touch **Scan for devices**. The phone will search for your Toyota multimedia system.

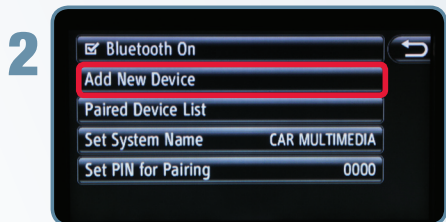
# STEP 2 INITIATE *BLUETOOTH*<sup>®1</sup> ON YOUR MULTIMEDIA SYSTEM

Now that you have *Bluetooth*<sup>®</sup> on your phone ready to pair, you need to initiate *Bluetooth*<sup>®</sup> on your multimedia system. Please look at the choices below and select the instructions for the multimedia system that most closely resembles the one in your vehicle.

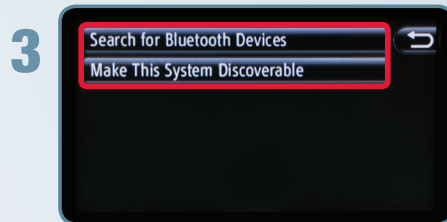
## Display Audio



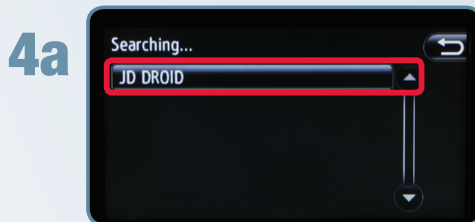
Press the **Setup** button on the faceplate, then touch **Bluetooth**.



Touch **Add New Device**.



Touch **Search for Bluetooth Devices** or **Make This System Discoverable**.



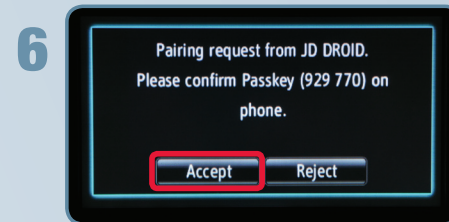
If you touched **Search for Bluetooth Devices**, a list of discovered devices will appear. Touch the device to be paired.



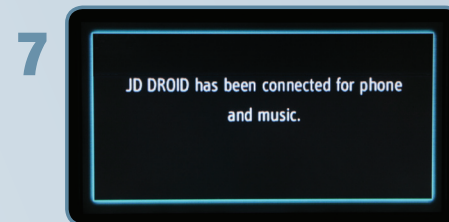
If you touched **Make This System Discoverable**, select **CAR MULTIMEDIA** on your smartphone.



A message will direct you to start the pairing process on your phone. Touch **Pair** on your phone when prompted.



Touch **Accept** to pair your smartphone to your vehicle. You also may need to enter the supplied Passkey on your phone.



A confirmation will appear that your phone has been paired and connected.

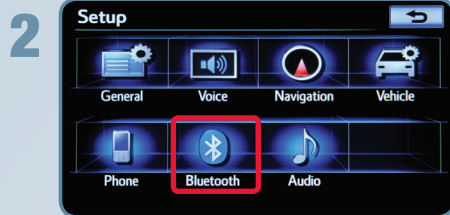


Press the **MENU** button on the faceplate, then touch **Setup**.

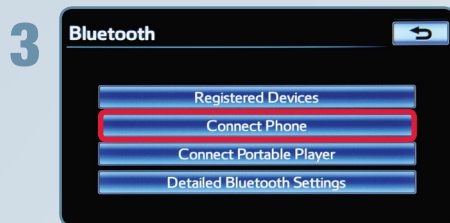
## Premium HDD Navigation with Entune® and JBL®



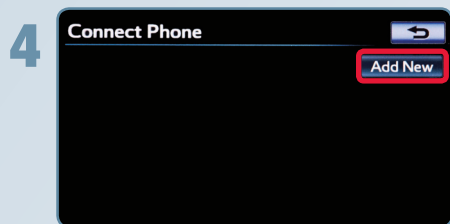
Press the **Setup** button on the faceplate.



Touch **Bluetooth**.



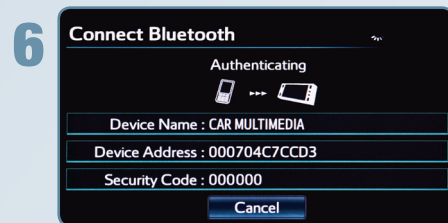
Touch **Connect Phone**.



Touch **Add New**.



The system will begin searching for your phone. Your phone should have **CAR MULTIMEDIA** listed as a device ready to pair.



Touch **CAR MULTIMEDIA** on your phone to initiate pairing.



Verify your phone is attempting to pair. You may need to enter a security code on your phone to confirm.



A confirmation will appear that your phone has been paired and connected.
